Findings in the audit of Macon County

Recorder of Deeds' Accounting Procedures

The Recorder of Deeds does not always issue receipt slips for the full amount received when overpayments are made, so the total amount of receipts cannot be reconciled to the total amount of deposits. The Recorder of Deeds does not reconcile the bank balance to the book balance and does not reconcile the liabilities with the cash balances. At the end of 2012, the bank balance was \$369 short of the book balance, and the cash balance exceeded the list of liabilities by \$657.

Public Administrator's Annual Settlements

The Public Administrator does not always file annual settlements timely. Of the 41 cases managed by the Public Administrator with an annual settlement due in 2012, 9 (22 percent) annual settlements were not filed timely, and one was never filed. The acting Probate Clerk admittedly did not always timely notify the Public Administrator that annual settlements were due, but such failure does not excuse the Public Administrator from making the settlements on time as required by state law.

Additional Comments

Because counties are managed by several separately-elected individuals, an audit finding made with respect to one office does not necessarily apply to the operations in another office. The overall rating assigned to the county is intended to reflect the performance of the county as a whole. It does not indicate the performance of any one elected official or county office.
