

Missouri voters approve Constitutional Amendment 1.

Yes votes: 1,469,093 (62%)
No votes: 899,613 (38%) ¹

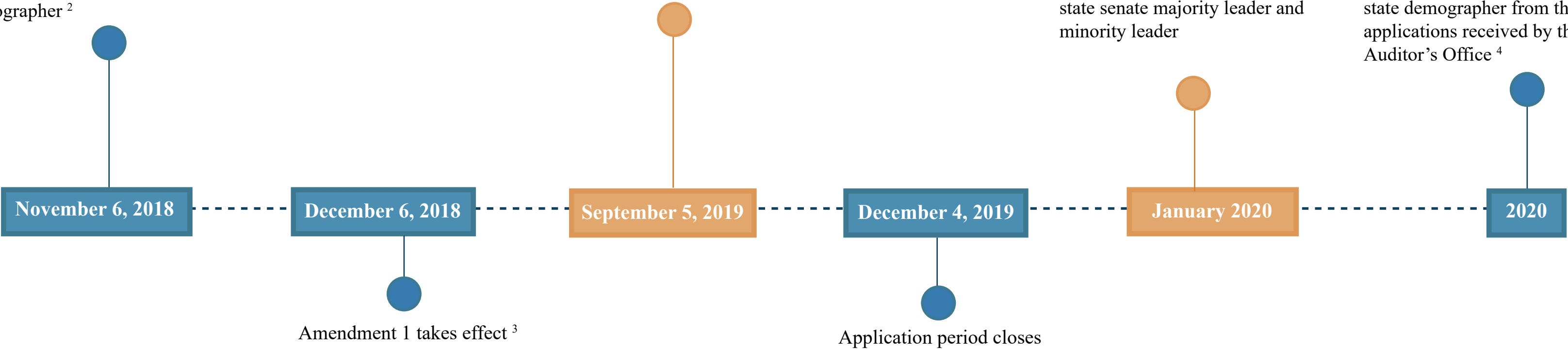
Amendment 1 included a number of provisions, including the creation of the position of nonpartisan state demographer ²

Application for nonpartisan state demographer will be available at auditor.mo.gov

Applicants have 90 days to apply. Completed applications will be posted to auditor.mo.gov for public review and transparency

State Auditor's Office will deliver completed applications to the state senate majority leader and minority leader

The state senate majority leader and minority leader select the nonpartisan state demographer from the completed applications received by the State Auditor's Office ⁴
