During a conversation that I had with the constituent last Friday, I was told that in August 2024, the State Auditor's Office began an audit of the City of Louisiana at the request of the Mayor. This request resulted after the Mayor terminated the employment of the former City Administrator.

Can you please advise the Senator's office when you expect to have that audit available for public review?

Also, can you please provide the Senator's office with the cost/anticipated cost that will be charged to the City of Louisiana for the audit?
